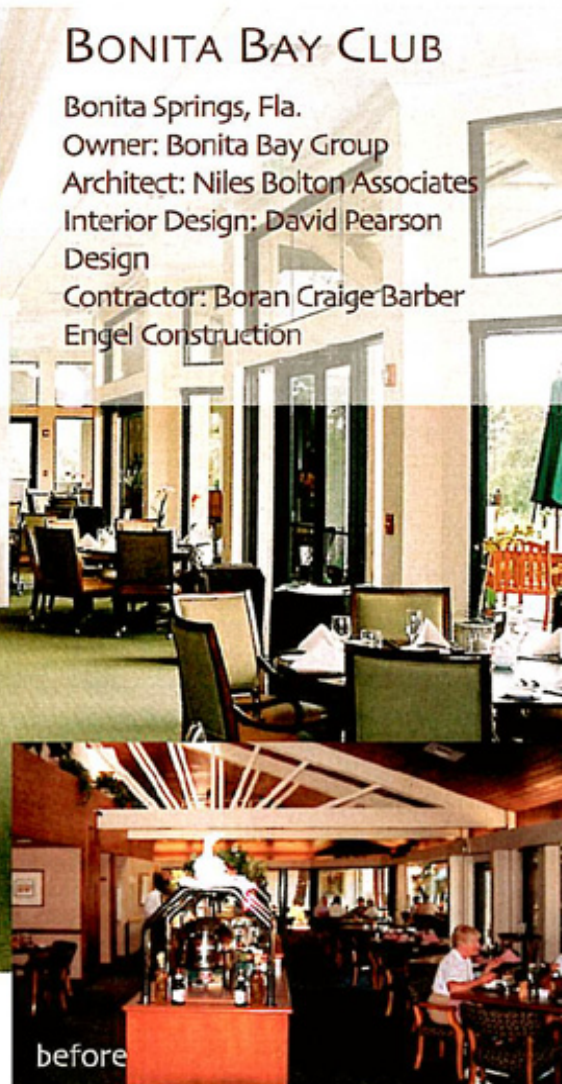

THE INSIDE STORY

Seeking to reorganize the clubhouse design of its flagship club, the Bonita Bay Group launched a renovation to give the club a personality and to connect the interior and exterior dining spaces. In addition, owners wanted to increase the capacity of the banquet area. A small addition to the west façade of the building connected casual dining and function spaces. The roof in the dining areas was raised to more than 13 feet to provide a feeling of spaciousness. A new bar was created in the casual dining area and an expanded formal dining room was added. The work also included a renovated member entry and lobby area to serve as a prefunction area.
